



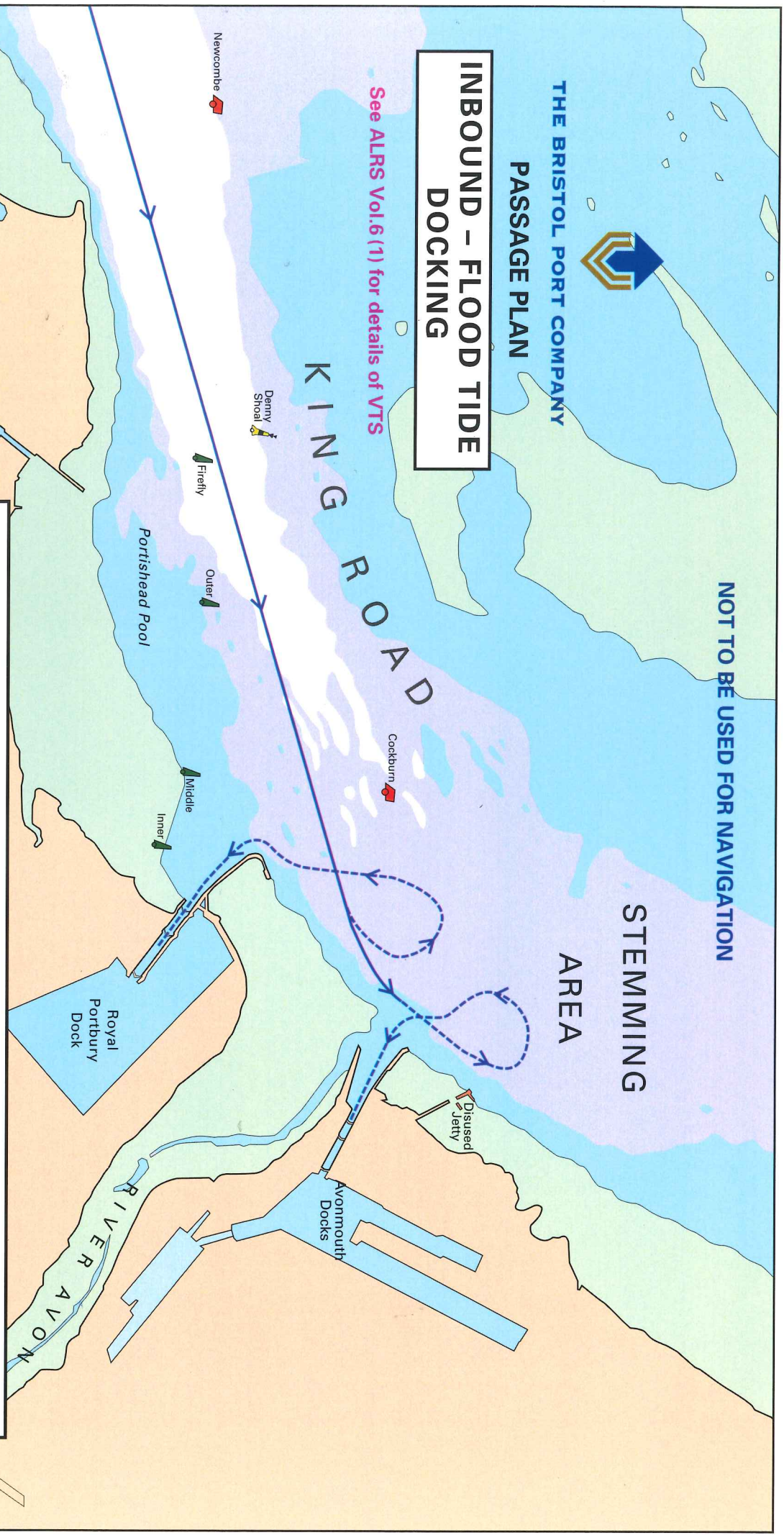

NAVIGATIONAL CONDUCT RADIO PROCEDURES

1. Inbound vessels should keep to the starboard side of the main channel prior to swinging to port and stemming the tide.
1. Vessels to maintain watch on VHF Ch. 12 until entering the lock.
2. When entering the lock vessels should listen on VHF Ch. 14 for instructions from Lock Controllers.
3. Once secure in the lock vessels must call Avonmouth Dock Radio or Portbury Dock Radio on VHF Ch. 14 for berthing instructions.
4. Vessels must contact Avonmouth Dock Radio or Portbury Dock Radio on VHF Ch. 14 when lock is up and the lock gates are fully open to obtain permission to leave the lock.
